Public Comment

Bill Walton: Township Resident Bill Walton inquired about an assessment that was included on this tax bill from County. The new tax bill included an assessment for street lights. He indicated he lives in Country Squire and has not street lights located on his street. He requested the Township remove this fee from his tax bill.

Don and Cathy Martin: Township Residents Don and Cathy Martin also inquired about the street light assessment that appeared on their bill. He would like to see this assessment removed from his bill and also indicated that he does not have street lights. He suggested a possible lower fee for residents of Country Squire who do not have street lights but have access to the recreational area located in the development.

Dawn Blauch: Township Resident Dawn Blauch noted that the second-class township code allows for the Board to charge residents for street lights. She also noted that some developments have different zoning which is why some portions of certain developments have a higher concentration of street lights.

New Business:

Board of Supervisor Candidate: The Township received one letter of interest for the Board of Supervisor vacancy. This letter was from Bill Bova. A motion by Custer second by Bucks to appoint Bill Bova as Township Supervisor to fill the vacancy left by Doug Cheyney with a term to expire 12/31/19. Also added was the condition he resign from the School Board as he may not hold both positions. Motion carried.
