Natural Areas Committee: None

Water Quality Committee:

- Discussion to write a water quality article for newsletter, possibly focusing on private well testing. Kristin volunteered to write article, will send to Megan for submission to Township Newsletter.

Agricultural Committee: None

Pipeline Monitoring Committee:

- Site activities of Atlantic Sunrise currently include mobilization of equipment and materials to active site locations, topsoil sampling and segregation, clearing operations (trees and landscaping) installation of sediment controls and project signage, staking of ROW.
- Crossing of all creeks in township, including Conewago Creek, between now and February 28, 2018.
- Lebanon Rails to Trails in Lawn: Transco intends to close the trail for “approximately two weeks” and determined no alternative route (detour) was feasible. Construction activities at site will last approximately 12 weeks.
- No Horizontal Directional Drilling (HDD) in South Londonderry Township.

Landscaping Committee: Rugh made a motion to suspend committee, Soon 2nd. Motion carried.

Old Business:

- Community Garden Proposal: Rugh made a motion to send proposal materials present to the Supervisors, Kristen 2nd the motion. Motion carried.

- Hometown Habitat: Sid advised to possibly use Urban + Suburban Meadows in the future as educational materials for township – deemed other DVD not appropriate.
- Kristin will see if alternate information is available from the Ag. Extension (for potential training of township staff.)

New Business:

- EAC Donations: Dick Brown informed the EAC of a \$500 donation to the EAC from Pat Krebs on 1/23/2012, which went into the general fund of the township. The EAC also received a \$2000 donation from Don Lechleitner in 2009 (also in general fund) and \$500 was spent to plant North Meadow in Campbelltown Park. The EAC should have funds of roughly \$2000.
- Rugh made a motion to ask Jenna for an EAC account and have funds transferred into account. Soon 2nd the motion. Motion carried. Sid will ask Jenna for an EAC account.
- Thank-You Letters: Megan made a motion to ask Jenna to thank Pat Krebs and Don Lechleitner (on behalf of township) for their donations to the EAC, Rugh 2nd motion. Motion carried.
