**Opening Ceremonies and Introduction-** The meeting was called to order at 7:00M by Chairwoman Bucks followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

**Changes to Agenda:** There were no changes to the agenda.

**Public Comment:** There was no public comment.

**New Business**

**Hinkle Road – Discussion:** The Township send letters to residents that own property on Hinkle Road. There was discussion on realigning this road to come out to the existing traffic circle located on S. Forge Road. Township residents Bill and Josie Ames were in attendance and had questions about the project as it may affect their property located on Hinkle Rd. Township resident Ed Houser asked if the road will remain a two-way street. A motion by Custer second by Bova to have Township Engineer Rettew draw up a simple sketch that would enable the Township to advise the property owners whose properties that will be affected by the realignment. Motion carried.

**Annville Police Department Request for Fire Police Assistance:** A motion by Custer second by Faith to approve Annville Police Department’s request to have Campbelltown Fire Police assist with Annville’s Memorial Day Parade to be held on May 25, 2019. Motion carried.

**Sewer Planning Module – 237 Lawn Road Subdivision:** A motion by Custer second by Bova to approve the Sewer Planning Module for the 237 Lawn Road Subdivision with the condition that the Planning Commission also approve the module. Motion carried.

**Lawn Fire Dept. – Driveway:** A motion by Bucks second by Bova to approve the purchase of the pipe, stone and black top and other materials required to complete a repair of Lawn Fire Department’s driveway entrance not to exceed \$5,000. The fire department will be responsible to hire a contractor to complete the project. Vice Chairman Custer wanted the Board to know that he will most likely be completing the

repair but will not be charging Lawn Fire Company for his services and will have no financial gain from this project. Motion carried.

**Good and Welfare:**

**Fire Tax Reserve Fund:** Chairwoman Bucks asked about the reserve fund the fire departments are holding at the Township. The money comes from the fire tax and is marked for large future purchases.

**Executive Session:** An executive session will be held after the meeting to discuss a personnel issue.

**Adjourn** – There being no more business to discuss, a motion by Custer second by Bova to adjourn the meeting at 7:56 PM. Motion carried.
