New Business

FEMA Floodplain Map: FEMA supplied the Township with proposed changes to the Floodplain mapping. The new mapping will go into effect Summer 2019. Township residents whose property is either being removed or added from the Floodplain will be notified of this change via letter from the Township.

2018 Road Projects – Harvest Road and Drescher Road: A motion by Custer second by Bucks to approve the request for bids advertisement for repairs to Drescher Road and Harvest Road with Lyndel as an alternate. Motion carried. Public Works Director Galbraith will place advertisement in the paper and utilize Penn Bid for bidding documents.

Mariner East Grants: A motion by Custer second by Bucks to approve Rettew to prepare a grant to submit to Mariner East to fund an MS4 project in the Township to be determined at a later time. Motion carried.

Good and Welfare:

Zoning Hearing: Township Manager Seesholtz indicated that there will be a Zoning Hearing on April 30, 2018 for the property located at 20 W. Market Street, which is the old township building. The Board did not have any opposition to the request by the applicants to make this structure into an 8 unit apartment building.
