Historic Homes Inventory

Rugh Henderson led a discussion emphasizing our original mission to “identify, record, promote and preserve the rich historical assets of our community,” focusing largely on its rich historical properties.

With a focus on pre-1920s properties, the committee agreed that a more concerted effort be made to encourage residents of Campbelltown, Colebrook, Lawn and Mt. Gretna to share information about their homes to further enhance our historical inventory. Some methods for pursuing this end were discussed, including articles in the South Londonderry newsletter, examples of existing input, as well as providing brochures and survey forms to be disseminated at our community’s annual National Night Out.
