Ideas mentioned include: Preservation Award, Community Events, Walking Tours, Speakers, Oral / Digital Presentations, and historical articles to be placed on the Township’s website {i.e., weather history or notable people buried in local cemeteries, etc.}. Commission members should forward any additional ideas to Cindy as soon as possible.

- ✓ National Night Out will now be held at Palmyra Field; the Commission will evaluate our continuing with National Night Out once the Township Ordinance No. 182 has been revised.
