Note: The South Londonderry Township Historical Commission met in the South Londonderry Township Building, Campbelltown.

Cindy Skinner opened the meeting. No minutes of the of the 3/11/24 meeting were available, the meeting having been cancelled.

General Discussion/Old Business/Updates:

Cindy Skinner announced Commission member Trevor Kase - Secretary had resigned as a result of his having moved from the Township.

The two volumes of World War II letters, photos and clippings created by Campbelltown native Richard Brandt and donated by his wife Liz. They have been transcribed and they are working on making them available on line at LebTown.org.

The Commission members reviewed the Township's recipients of the annual Preservation Award going back to 2012 and voted to present the 2024 Preservation Award to the Conewago Hotel of Mount Gretna. The Hotel, built in 1909, was dismantled in 1940 and the still existing Bath House, now owned by Dean Otto, would be representative of the original hotel, one of the first in the country to offer private baths, telephones in the rooms and an elevator.

Election of officers for 2024 was held with the following results: Cindy Skinner - Chair, Susan Bucks - Vice Chair/PR and William Jackson - Secretary.

Discussion was held on following up on Township Ordinance 182 for possible revisions. Commission member Steve Alger will head the review.
