**Public Comment:**

Pat Krebs – Commented on the recent Dinosaur Rock graffiti cleaning, the lack of sidewalks on the corner of Rt. 322 and Palmyra Road, 2006 Map of Walkability, Dangerous intersection at Schoolhouse and Eby Road, lack of connect-ability between Country Squire and Stone Knoll developments and the cancellation of the June Board and Workshop meetings.

Jane Popko - Commented she thought the newly installed walking bridge in the Campbelltown Community Park was not ADA compliant, requested an agenda item be added to the next meeting to discuss the use of the American Rescue Plan funds, and requested a sign at the entrance of the Campbelltown Community Park.

**Approval of the Minutes:**

A motion was made by Custer, seconded by Bucks to approve the May 14, 2024 Board of Supervisors Meeting Minutes. Motion carried.

The May 22, 2024 Workshop Meeting was cancelled.

A motion was made by Custer, seconded by Bucks to approve the Bill and Payroll Lists from 10, 11, 12, 13 & 14-2024. Motion carried.

### **Reports:**

Manager's Report- Eberly reported the 20<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Campbelltown tornado is later this week and the local media will be mentioning this item. The free shred event for this coming Friday at the 1805 Russel Road Refuse Authority site is on the website. National Night Out is scheduled for August 6, 2024 at the Palmyra Middle School. The first phase of the Killinger Creek stream restoration and riparian buffer project has been completed.

### **Other Reports-**

Monthly reports were provided for the Police Department, Sewer Authority, Palmyra Library, Historical Commission, Palmyra Parks and Recreational Program, First Aid & Safety Patrol, Campbelltown, and the Lawn Fire Companies.

### **Old Business:**

The Campbelltown Fire Department requested a loan from the Township in the amount of \$721,392.95 for their new fire truck which will be arriving later this year. Discussion was held on the Campbelltown Fire Company contributing \$75,000 from their New Truck Fund to the Campbelltown Fire Tax Fund 04 along with using \$250,000 of the balance in this fund to pay for the \$996,392.95 amount owed on the new fire truck which is anticipated to arrive in late 2024.

A motion was made by Custer, seconded by Bova to approve a loan to the Campbelltown Fire Company in the form of a transfer out of the General Fund 01 to the Campbelltown Fire Tax Fund 04 in amount of \$671,392.95 for the new fire truck. Motion carried.

### **New Business:**

A motion was made by Custer, seconded by Bucks to approve the advertisement of the Open Burn, Recycling and Disposal of Waste Ordinances as required under the ACT 101 compliance mandate. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Custer, seconded by Bucks to approve the experimental removal of the No Parking Signs on Woodlawn Road in an attempt for a speed reduction initiative. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Custer, seconded by Bucks to approve the Financial Security reduction for the Stonebrook South Development from \$663,621.70 to \$150,014.88 per the Rettew Review letter dated July 8, 2024. Motion carried.
