Special Orders:

Angela Shea, Garcia Garman & Shea, PC reviewed the 2022 Annual Audit Report and Financial Statements for South Londonderry Township. No material findings were found, and the Township continues to be in a strong financial position.

Public Comment:

Michael Corricelli, introduced himself as a candidate running of the open District Magistrate position.

Pat Krebs advocated for volunteers to assist with removal of graffiti on Dinosaur Rock located on State Game lands on June 10, 2023. She spoke about the on-going crosswalk initiative and touched upon the availability of the Zoning Ordinance Rewrite.

Jane Popko inquired on the status of the LSA grant for the Campbelltown Park walking bridge.

Approval of the Minutes:

A motion was made by Bova, seconded by Bucks to approve the April 11, 2023 Board of Supervisors Meeting Minutes. Motion carried.

The April 26, 2023 Workshop Meeting was cancelled.

A motion was made by Bova, seconded by Bucks to approve the Bill and Payroll Lists from 08 & 09-2023. Motion carried.

Reports:

Manager's Report- Eberly reminded residents to vote at the primary elections next week. He thanked CCA for their successful Clean-up Event the other week and reminded residents to maintain keeping their lawns mowed and help their neighbors requiring assistance.

Zoning Report- None.

Solicitor's Report – None, but Chairwoman Bucks announced that the Board would be going into Executive Committee after the Board meeting to discuss a personnel topic.

Discussion was held on the proposal to have the quarterly sewer bill for Mt. Gretna sewer customers reflected on the annual 2024 Lebanon County Real Estate Tax bill.

A motion was made by Bova seconded by Bucks to table the decision for 2024 consolidating the quarterly sewer bills into an annual bill to be reflected on the 2024

Lebanon County Real Estate Tax Bills for the Mt. Gretna Sewer customers. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Bova seconded by Bucks to approve the Subdivision and Land Development Plan for the 212 Lawn Road property conditional to Rettew's April 11, 2023 review #1 letter and comments from the Planning Commission. Motion carried.
