He also reminded residents to remove basketball hoops from the edge of roads, so not to be damaged or interfere with the upcoming snow removal process. Multimodal grant funds for the proposed roundabout at Airport and Forge Roads has been denied. Eberly reported several residents inquired about the 'games of skills' machines recently installed at the Turkey Hill on Horseshoe Pike. Since these machines are considered 'games of skill' a court case is pending, but these machines are currently legal under the current interpretation of the state law.
